



Scotiabank Offering Electronic Bill Payment for Hand in Hand Fire Insurance

Georgetown, August 6, 2014. Customers of Hand in Hand Mutual Fire Insurance Company Limited who have an active account with Scotiabank in Guyana can now pay their fire insurance premiums electronically using Scotia Online® and Scotia Mobile®.

This is the second insurance company to sign on to Scotiabank's electronic bill payment service.

The other bill payment companies currently on board are GTM Insurance Company, Guyana Power and Light (GPL), Digicel, Guyana Telephone and Telegraph Company (GT&T), Guyana Water Inc. (GWI), E-Networks, School of The Nations and Westfield Prep School.

Scotia Online® and Scotia Mobile® are safe, convenient ways to pay bills using a computer or internet-enabled cellphone.

Scotiabank account holders must first sign up for Scotia Online® by visiting the Bank's website www.guyana.scotiabank.com, before signing up for Scotia Mobile®. Once the account holder signs up successfully for online banking, the next step is to go to www.scotiamobile.com on their mobile phone to sign up for Scotia Mobile® using the same sign up information from Scotia Online®. The customer then clicks on "Register this device" to activate Scotia Mobile®.

Other transactions that can be done via the two services are Mastercard® bill payments, funds transfers between Scotiabank accounts and third party transfers to other Scotiabank account holders in Guyana, including businesses.

Customers can also view their transaction history for all personal accounts, including balances for loans and deposits, as well as sign up to receive their bank statements electronically.

The services are currently free to Scotiabank account holders.
